- Create a scrapbook of notes, photos, and articles that you have collected.

- Draw a rough sketch of your floor plan and take measurements (or, if building, get floor plan from architect or builder).

If you decide to proceed with the project, we will now . . .

- Provide you with a written contract outlining the specific products and services that we will be supplying to you for your project.
- Upon your final acceptance we will ask for a deposit from you so we can order your cabinetry.
- If you prefer, we can make arrangements with your builder, architect, and/or designer to coordinate our installation.
- If you prefer, we can remove and dispose of your existing cabinetry and appliances.
- Cabinet installation will be performed with our own in-house craftsmen 4-5 weeks after order placement. If you or your builder / contractor are not ready for installation at that time, we can store your cabinetry in our warehouse at no additional cost to you.
- We will meet with you after installation to assure your complete satisfaction of our products and services.
